# CAMP DIRECTOR

**Graeme Orr**, native of Eaglesham, Scotland, was an assistant coach at the University of North Alabama for two seasons. While at UNA, Orr helped the Lions' soccer team become the most improved women's soccer team in the nation. In 2009, the Lions made their first appearance in the GSC Women's Soccer Tournament since 1999 and their first appearance in the NCAA Division II Regionals in the program's history, including the school's first post-season win, a 3-2 victory over Florida Southern. Along with his duties in Florence, Ala., Orr also served as a head coach for the Alabama Olympic Development Program.



Orr is a 2007 graduate of Martin Methodist College in Pulaski, Tenn. where he played four seasons for the Redhawks. During his collegiate career, he helped guide MMC to the Trans-South regular season and post-season championships in 2004. Orr received a B.S. in Sports Management and was awarded the Sports Management award in 2007.

Prior to his time in Florence, Orr spent a year working for the Alabama Youth Soccer Association in Birmingham. His role was as the Programs Director and he aided with projects such as Soccer Start and the Olympic Development Program or ODP.

Orr has a number of coaching licenses which include NSCAA Advanced National, USSF 'C' License, US Youth Soccer National Youth License, Scottish F.A. Level 3 in Children & Youth, and Scottish F.A. Level 1 in Goalkeeping and Adult.
