

ENROLLMENT INFORMATION

How to Enroll

Please mail the completed application and medical form, along with a deposit of \$200 for the overnight camp (\$50 for day campers). Or, you may send the entire camp fee at once. The balance is due by **May 25, 2011**. If applying after May 15, send full payment. Those who are unable to attend camp for medical or other reasons will be refunded all but a \$50 handling fee (\$25 for day campers). In order to receive the refund, the Wulf Koch Soccer Academy must be notified at least 72 hours prior to registration on Sunday.

Camp Ball

Each camper **MUST** have a soccer ball at camp. Bring your own ball or buy a quality ball at camp for \$15. Please mark the appropriate box for this in the application form.

Camp Insurance

The Wulf Koch Soccer Academy carries secondary medical insurance. Parents are expected to provide primary coverage for their child.
